With the giving season upon us, the Roslyn School Foundation (RSF) is reaching out to families with an update on our most recent projects and to launch our annual Holiday Campaign.

2014-2015 Projects

- **Beautification grant** Thanks to **our generous donors**, over \$6,500 was raised during the Foundation's 2014 Holiday Campaign that in turn unlocked a \$30,000 grant from the EMSB and the Ministry of Education, Leisure and Sports.
- **New desks for Grade 6** With financial support from the **Hylcan Foundation**, Roslyn's Grade 6 students will receive new classroom desks.
- **Communications system for safety** In response to the need for a school-wide communication system, a Grade 1 teacher came up with the idea to install internet phones at a fraction of the cost of a traditional intercom system. With the help of the **Zeller Family Foundation**, this project is becoming a reality.
- **Classroom needs** Concerned about teachers spending out of pocket for equipment required to teach the curriculum, **Roslyn parents** sprang into action. Funds totalling over \$1,750 were donated to classrooms and the gym.
- **Library** Librarian **Mary Moroska** requested donations to the Roslyn School Foundation to be directed to the Library in lieu of retirement gifts. A thank you to Mary and to the parents who gave to support the library!
